According to the regulations of the General Equal Treatment Act (AGG), the employer is obliged to take suitable measures to protect against disadvantages due to discrimination. Pursuant to § 12 AGG, this also includes preventive measures, such as the publication of the law text in the workplace or regular employee training.

Employees' knowledge of their own rights and obligations is a prerequisite for a fair and successful working atmosphere.

A compact web-based training on these topics is easy to use – even on a mobile tablet.

Motivating training with a manageable time expenditure of approx. 25 minutes

By means of storytelling, your employees will be introduced to the rules and regulations of the AGG in an entertaining and memorable way. The main character, Lena, is given the task of preparing the AGG for her colleagues in a way that they can understand. She leads through the program and the topic sections. The learners accompany Lena and see the results of her research and experiences in authentic situations, which are presented through short explanatory videos. Basics, regulations and examples from everyday work are always presented in context.

Learners can identify well with the content and thus develop a sustainable understanding of equal treatment in working life. They learn how to handle exceptional situations. The web-based training concludes with a small knowledge test.
